TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Each team will consist of 2 bowlers (1 Female / 1 Male)
2. This is not a certified USBC tournament.
3. Entry fee will be \$60.00 per team if pre-registered, \$70.00 per team if registered day of tournament.
4. Handicap will be determined on a scale of 85% of 460, based off of the combined averages of each team member. (For example: If Jane has an average of 160 and her teammate, John, has an average of 210, then Jane-John's average will be 370, with a handicap of 76. $(160+210=370, 460-370=90*0.85=76)$).
5. Average Rule:
 - a. The highest 2008/2009 USBC book average of twenty-one (21) or more games will be used
 - b. If no 2008/2009 USBC book average, the highest 2007/2008 USBC book average of twenty-one (21) or more games will be used.
 - c. If no 2007/2008 USBC book average, the highest USBC book average of twenty-one (21) or more games as listed on bowl.com will be used.
 - d. All others will use a 230 average.
6. Each team will bowl 6 games in the Scotch Doubles format.
 - a. Females will start games 1, 3 and 5.
 - b. If a 9-pin No-Tap or a Strike is rolled, the male will bowl the first shot of the second frame.
 - c. If neither a 9-Pin No-Tap or a Strike are rolled, the male will attempt to pick-up the remaining pins and the female will bowl the first shot of the second frame. This will continue until the female rolls a 9-Pin No-Tap or a Strike, at which time the male will bowl the first shot of the next frame.
 - d. Males will start games 2, 4 and 6.
 - e. When in the 10th frame, if a 9-Pin No-Tap or a Strike is rolled on the first shot, the teammate will bowl the second shot.
 - f. If a 9-Pin No-Tap or a Strike is rolled on the second shot, the bowler who rolled the first 9-Pin No-Tap or Strike in the 10th frame will bowl the third shot.
 - g. If neither a 9-Pin No-Tap or a Strike are rolled on the second shot, the bowler who rolled the 9-Pin No-Tap or Strike to open the 10th frame will attempt to pick-up the remaining pins.
7. The combined score for a team will be the sum of the total pin-count from the 6 games bowled and the team's total handicap for 6 games. (So, if Jane-John bowled scores of 209-228-187-193-204-279, then there total score will be $1300+(38*6)=1528$).
8. 100% of the prize fund will be returned in a 1 to 6 ratio.
9. In case of ties, the money will be added together and divided equally between the tied teams.
10. This is an adult tournament. USBC Youth bowlers are ineligible to participate.
11. Lane assignments will be made in the order entries are received.
12. Bowlers will move to the right 1 pair of lanes after game 2 and game 4.

NO-TAP STRIKE POTS

1. Entry into the six No-Tap Strike Pots is included with your entry fee.
2. \$12 per team is divided equally among the six No-Tap Strike Pots.
3. At the conclusion of each game, two names will be drawn for a chance to win the money in that games Strike Pot.
 - a. In order to win the money in the pot, the bowlers whose names was drawn must bowl a 9-Pin No-Tap (9 pins), NOT A STRIKE, on his/her choice of the lanes that are being used for the tournament.
 - b. If a 9-Pin No-Tap is rolled by both bowlers, then the bowlers split the Strike-Pot and the tournament continues with the next game.
 - c. If a 9-Pin No-Tap is rolled by just one bowler, then that bowler wins the Strike-Pot and the tournament continues with the next game.
 - d. If neither bowler rolls a 9-Pin No-Tap, then two more names will be drawn and the process will continue until the Strike Pot is won.

300 GAME SIDE POT

1. Entry into the six 300 Game Side Pots is included with your entry fee.
2. \$6 per team is added to the 300 Game Side Pot and will be divided equally by any team or teams that may shoot a 300 during the tournament.
3. If no team bowls a 300 game in the tournament the Side Pot money is added back into the prize fund to be distributed to the tournament winners.
